

**SCHOLARSHIP/MOBILITY ANNOUNCEMENT FOR STUDENTS OF
POSTGRADUATE INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE**
**Erasmus+ International Mobility/Scholarship Agreement, University of Las
Palmas de Gran Canaria (ULPGC), Spain**

The above mobility agreement submitted by the PGIS was successful and the guidelines of the mobility call was notified to the University of Peradeniya. Mobility students will receive a grant, can attend courses and use all the facilities available at the ULPGC with no additional tuition fees. All learning activities approved in the Learning Agreement and completed successfully must be fully recognized at the home university. The programme offers students the chance to gain cultural experience abroad, become familiar with other higher education systems and meet people from other countries, actively contributing to the process of international integration.

In Spain the mobility contribution is 800 Euros. The minimum duration is 3 months depending on the programme. An additional amount to cover travel expenses will be provided along with an insurance cover.

The students will have to apply in their home university and comply with the internal rules at first. Secondly the students accepted by the home university to participate in the Programme will be evaluated by the ULPGC, that will select the beneficiary candidates.

Among the study areas, following are most relevant to the PGIS students. The students have to choose from the subject areas as relevant to them when applying;

MSc Programmes in Disaster Management, Science Education, GIS and RS,
Engineering Geology, Bio Chemistry & Molecular Biology,
Computer Science (Please check courses relevant to you in the
website)

In addition, other programmes may be considered on a case by case basis for Doctoral Studies. All the students are hereby requested to visit the website and check the subject areas which may be relevant to them. Also please pay attention to the courses taught in English.

The students should make their preliminary application addressed to the Deputy Registrar/PGIS. The closing date of the applications will be 20th February, 2018. Thereafter, the Scholarship Committee of the PGIS will screen and evaluate the applications and send the names in priority basis to the University of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Spain, for final evaluation and award.

Following criteria would be considered when evaluating the applications:

- The cumulative GPA
- The relevant field of study which are offered in the host university
- Research interest/proven research records (Please submit your contribution to the research field – Abstracts, Papers, Poster presentations, your participation in research, with proof)
- The language ability (if you have any knowledge of Spanish, preferably considered)

The detailed scholarship offer is displayed separately, and emailed.

Undergraduate and master courses in ULPGC are taught mainly in Spanish (please find attached the courses offered in English language in our university)

PhD mobility could be made in English language (a research placement) but the research of the student should correspond to the research that the ULPGC is offering.
