1. Title of the Research Project

The title should be clear, precise and informative of the focus of the study. It should reflect the essence of the research and be easy to understand.

2. Background and Significance

This should include a brief review of related literature, clearly defined research question, hypothesis/eses and significance/s of the study.

3. Objective/s

State general and specific objective/s of the research.

4. Research Design and methods

- Outline the overall research approach and briefly describe experimental methods, data collection and analysis.
- Wherever applicable, define the population or sample of the study, and discuss sampling methods and sample size.
- If instruments like questionnaires or interviews are used in selecting study subjects and gathering data, provide details.
- Indicate how ethical concerns will be addressed, including informed consent, confidentiality, and any potential risks to participants wherever applicable.
- Indicate the status of obtaining permission from the relevant authorities for sample collection if required.

5. Time Schedule

Provide a realistic time schedule* for completing the research, breaking it down to key phases (e.g. literature review, gathering samples, data collection and analysis, publications, thesis writing, etc.)
